Create an Anonymous Group Email

Intergroup (and WSO) encourage all groups to create a dedicated Group email so members can contact the group, newcomers can ask questions about the meeting, and Intergroup can get in touch in case there's an error in the group's listing on Intergroup web site. A group email helps to keep groups from isolating. A member must check the email of course: many groups assign this service to the Literature person; others create a new mini-service position. It's worth talking about at a Business Meeting or at the 7th Tradition Break, if you haven't already created a group email.
